General Meeting Minutes

May 22, 2019, 7:00 – 7:30 pm

Present: 16 attendees (14 schools represented)

1. Welcome and introductions

President Dean McGee opened the meeting.

2. Adoption of agenda

As Trustee Garry Thind was unable to attend, the Board of Trustees update was removed. An update on a resource for after school programs was added to the end of the General Meeting agenda.

3. Adoption of minutes of the previous General Meeting

Motion: To adopt the minutes of the April 24, 2019 General Meeting as presented. CARRIED

4. BCCPAC Resolutions

Five advance resolutions from Surrey DPAC were voted on at the BCCPAC AGM:

- 2019.06 (IEPs for ADHD) was split into two resolutions on the floor; the first part was amended and carried, and the second part was defeated.
- 2019.07 (EAs) was amended and carried.
- 2019.08 (Menstrual Products) was amended and carried.
- 2019.09 (Operating Funds for Growing Districts) was amended but ultimately defeated.
- 2019.10 (Capital Funding for Portables) was carried.

Directors submitted an additional resolution from the floor (2019.18, Resolution Tracking), which was also amended and carried. Details of all resolutions are available in the 2018-19 Annual Report (<http://surreydpac.ca/wp-content/uploads/2019/05/Annual-Report-2019.pdf>).

29 Surrey PACs were eligible to vote at the AGM, although many did not choose to either send a representative or designate DPAC to vote on their behalf. With more votes at the AGM, Surrey schools would have a considerably more powerful voice.

5. Update on district food truck policy

City of Surrey bylaws appeared to be a stumbling block, as the district had been advised that food trucks were authorized only for use in designated parkland areas. However, City representatives recently confirmed that food trucks will be permitted to operate on school grounds for special events, provided the district confirms that the vendor is properly licensed with the City. Two PACs were randomly selected to pilot the draft guidelines.

6. After school programs resource

At DPAC's request, the district has begun a project to index all after school programs that are available within schools. Details on this will be presented at a future General Meeting.
