# What is C-SP?

- ▶ A school district department housed at DEC
- ▶ Staff are funded through Community Link funding
- ▶ Oversight and direction setting by Assistant Superintendent
- ▶ All programs are funded and built through donations, partnerships and partner groups
- ▶ C-SP consists of approximately 30 staff:
  - A Manager, 3 Coordinators, Facilitators, Outreach Workers and a District Office Clerk


# What does C-SP do?

- ▶ C-SP provides support, resources and programs for vulnerable learners and coordinates programming for NLC's:
  - Supports students to be ready, able and motivated to learn
  - Involves students in engaging and meaningful after school activities
  - Helps connect parents to the community agencies and community partners and services that can address their needs
  - Utilizes and mobilizes the community to support needs of our students and families

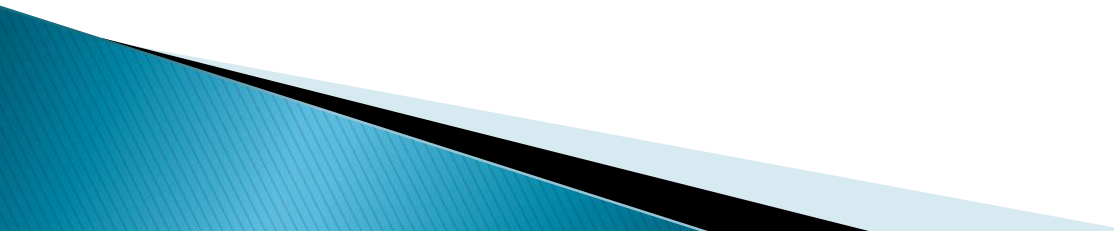
# What does this support look like?

- ▶ Programs that address chronic absenteeism (Attendance Matters)
  - ▶ Breakfast programs
  - ▶ After school programs ( BLAST, Roots, Connect)
  - ▶ Physical Literacy ( Jumpstart Academy; Play On)
  - ▶ Saturday programs ( Sticks and Stars Girls in Action)
  - ▶ Transition programs ( Girls groups and Boy groups)
  - ▶ Aboriginal programs ( Indigenous Games, Bannock and Books)
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# How do we create these programs?

- ▶ Programs utilize our partnerships with agencies such as YWCA, YMCA, City of Surrey
  - ▶ Community service providers offer enriching opportunities for students within our programs
  - ▶ Partners bring specific expertise to our programs
  - ▶ Partners provide funding to enable us to offer these opportunities
  - ▶ We work together with community tables and partners to address issues in the community
