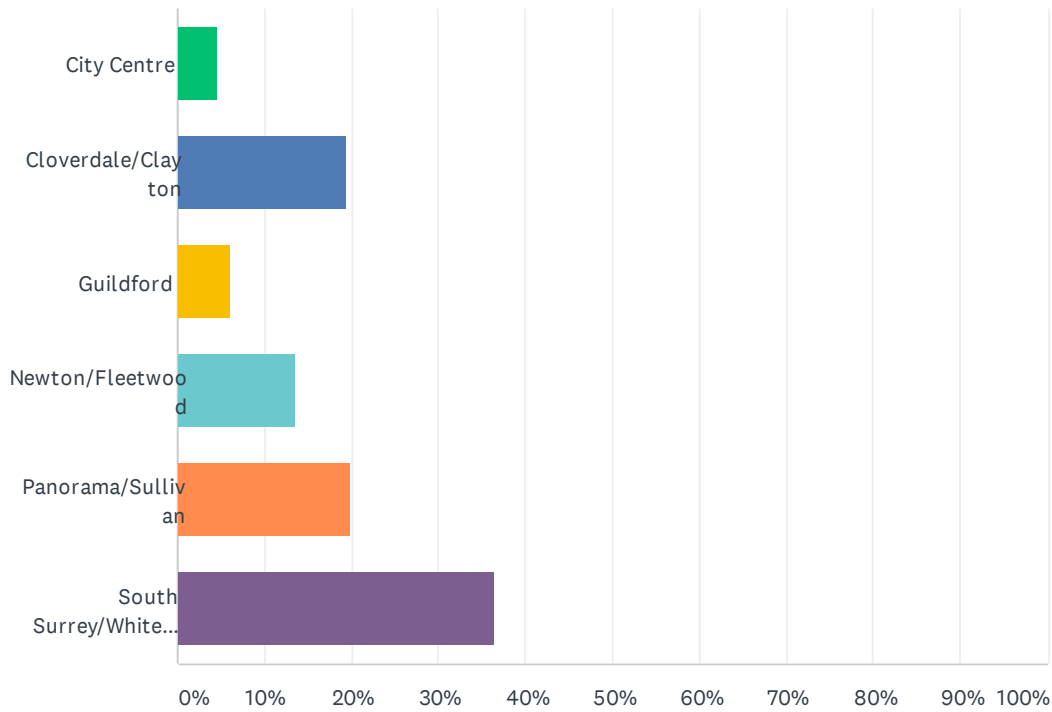


Q1 What area of Surrey is your child(ren)'s school in? (Check here if you are unsure.)

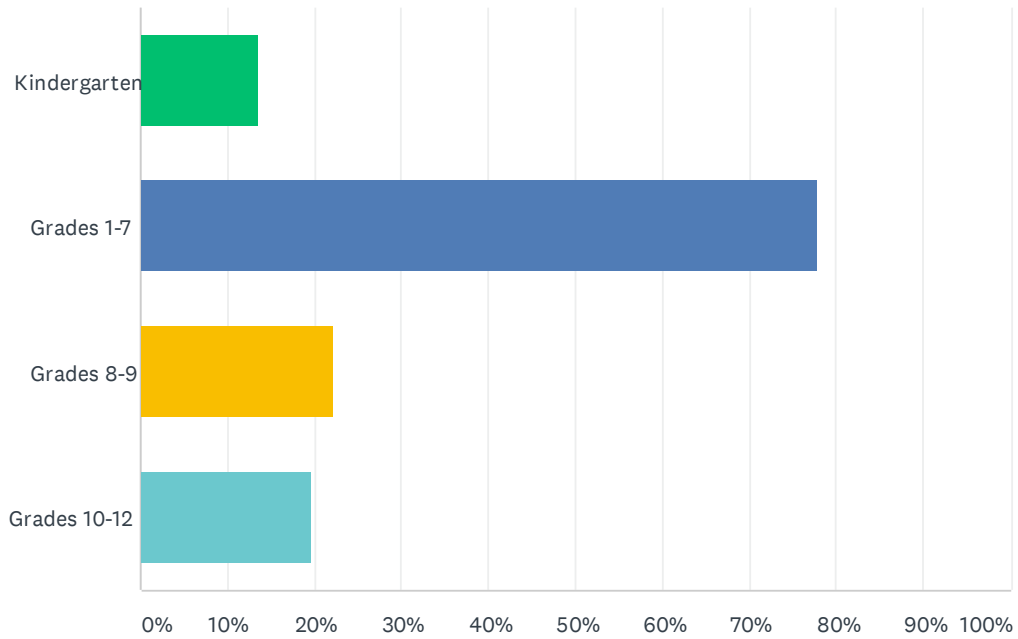

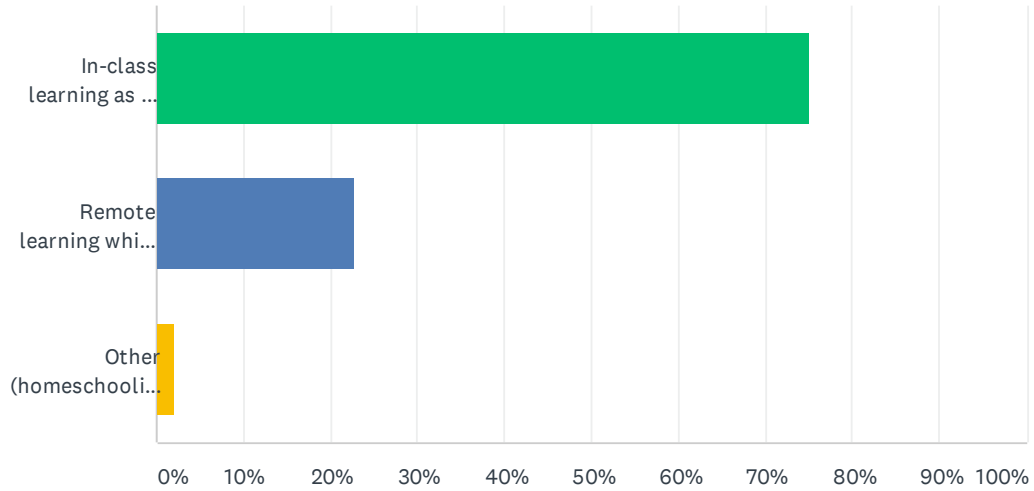

Q3 What model of learning is/are your child(ren) currently in?

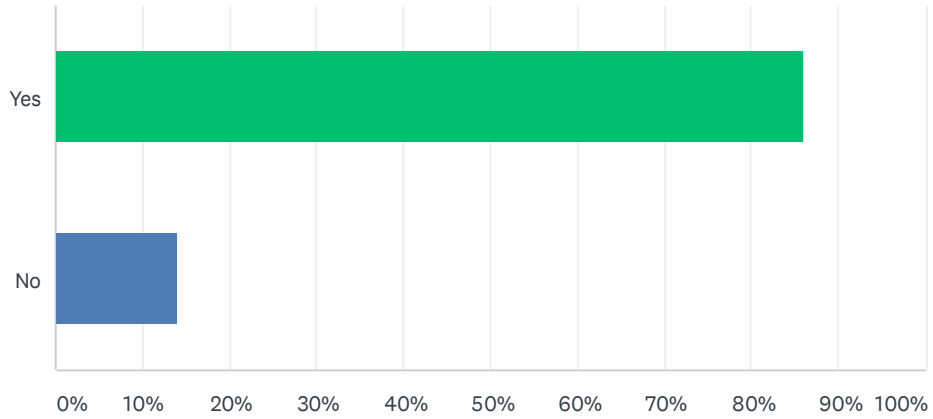

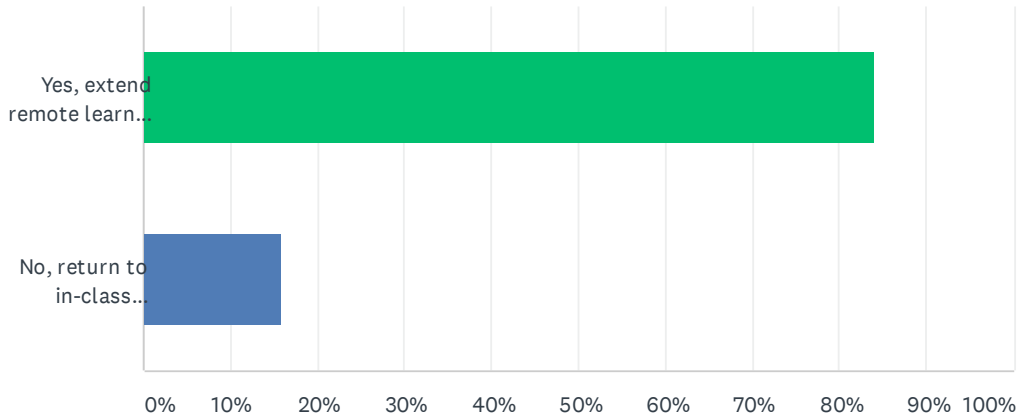

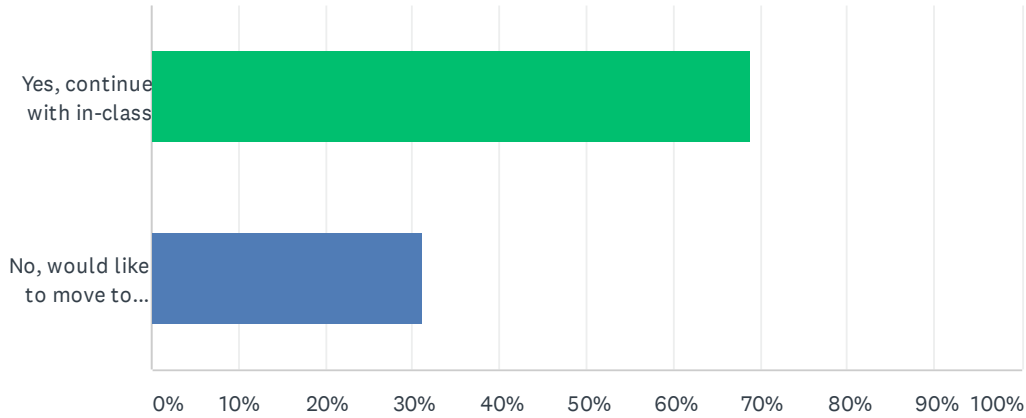

Q6 If currently attending in-class learning, do you plan to continue or would you like to move to remote learning? (Please SKIP if not doing in-class learning.)

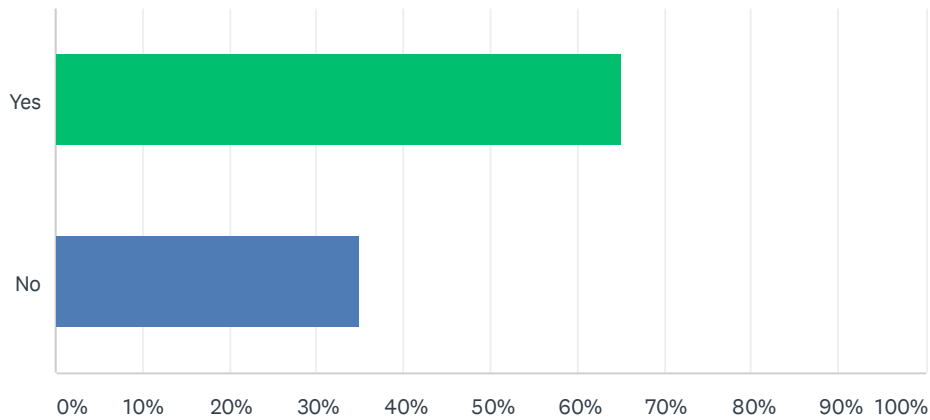

Q7 Would you like to see Surrey School District close the schools as the numbers rise in Surrey, regardless of what other districts do?

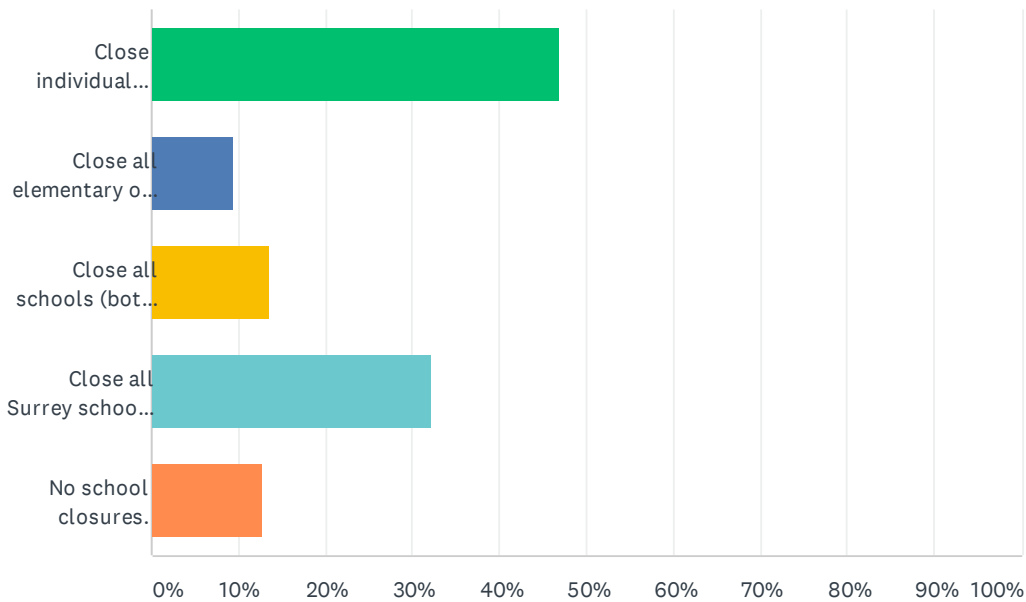

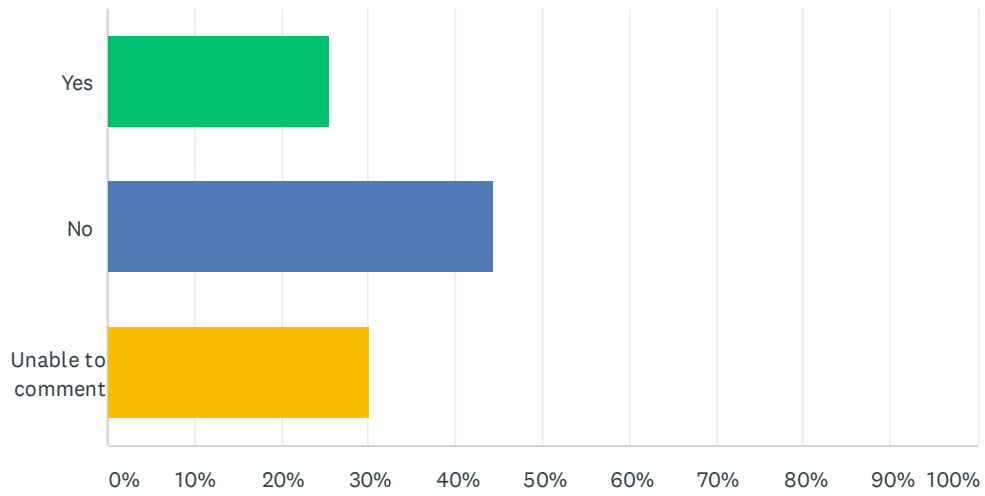

Q9 Are you satisfied with the quality/type of masks that were purchased by the School District and provided to students?

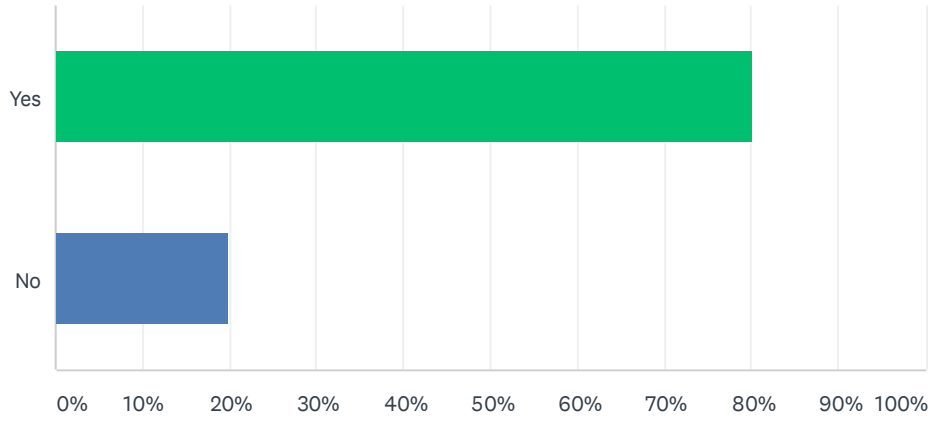

Q10 Would you like to see the School District purchase additional 3-layers masks as recommend by Dr. Tam?

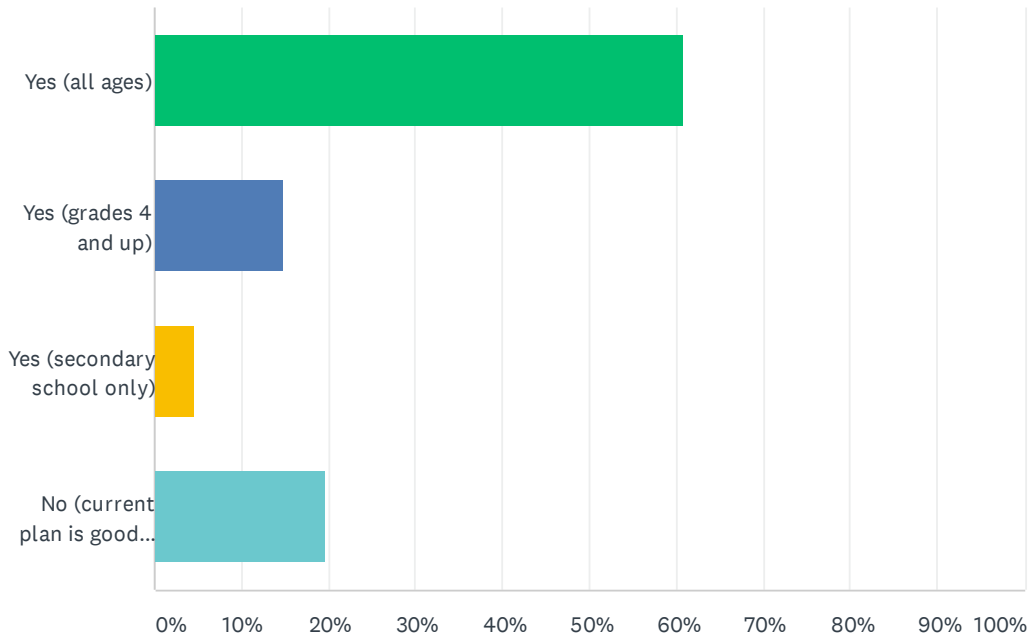

Q11 Would you like masks to be mandatory for all students all day (with exception to medical reasons), even when social distancing can be maintained?

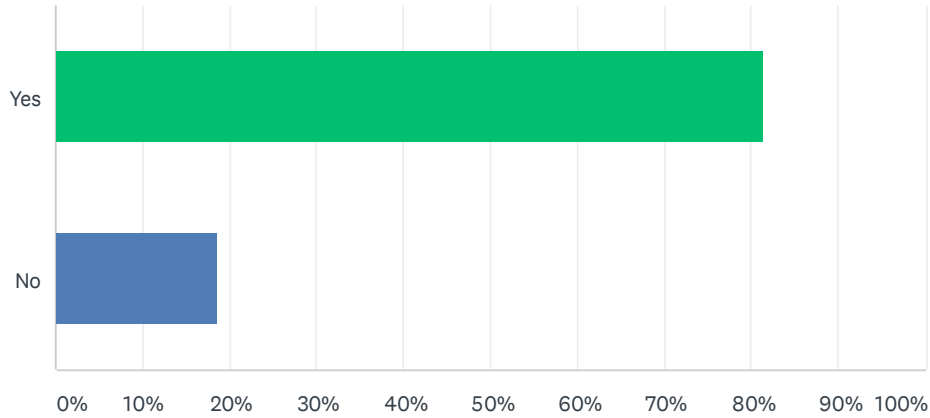

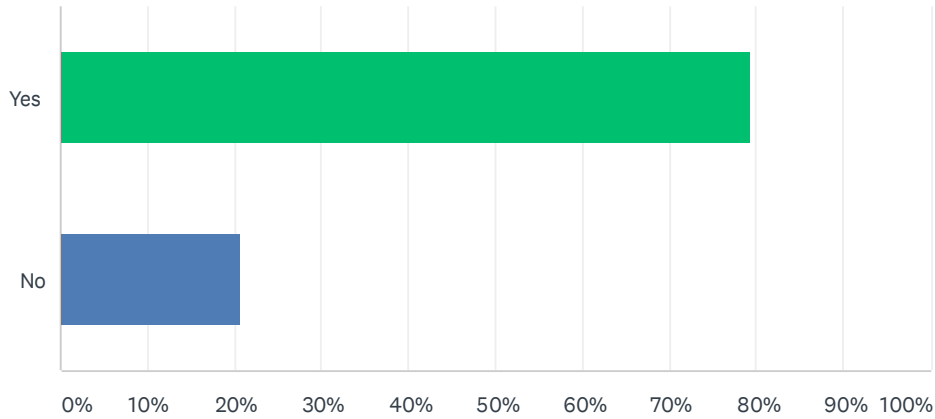

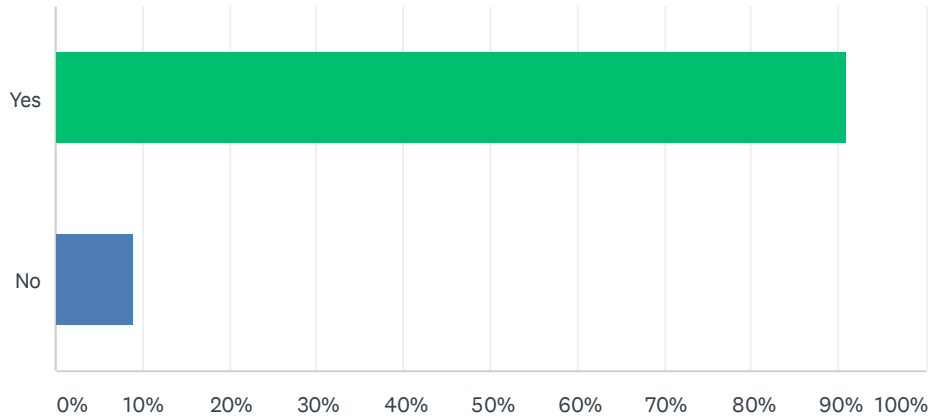

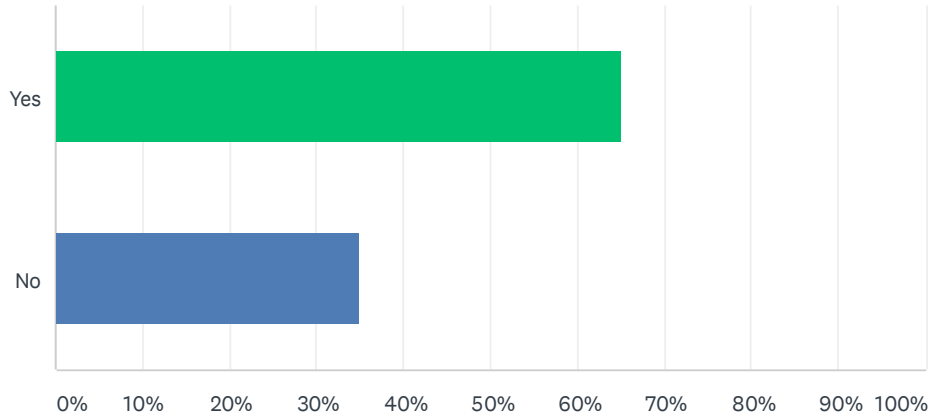

Q15 Do you think that the district would benefit from creating and implementing a cell phone policy for students, to govern use of phones in schools?

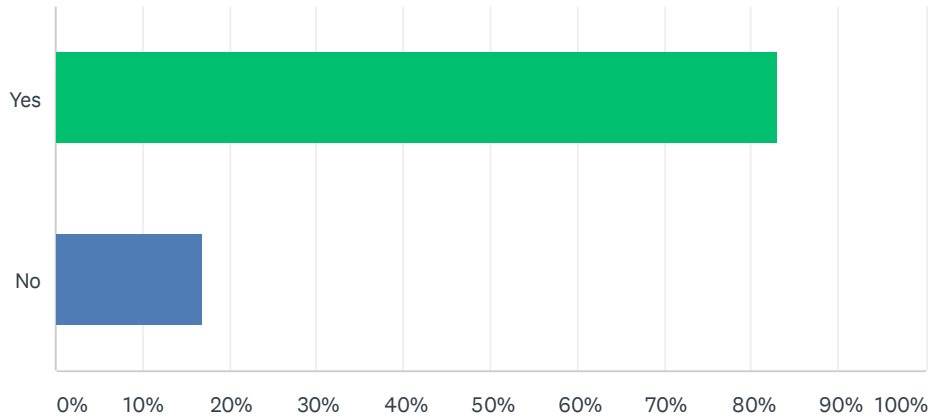

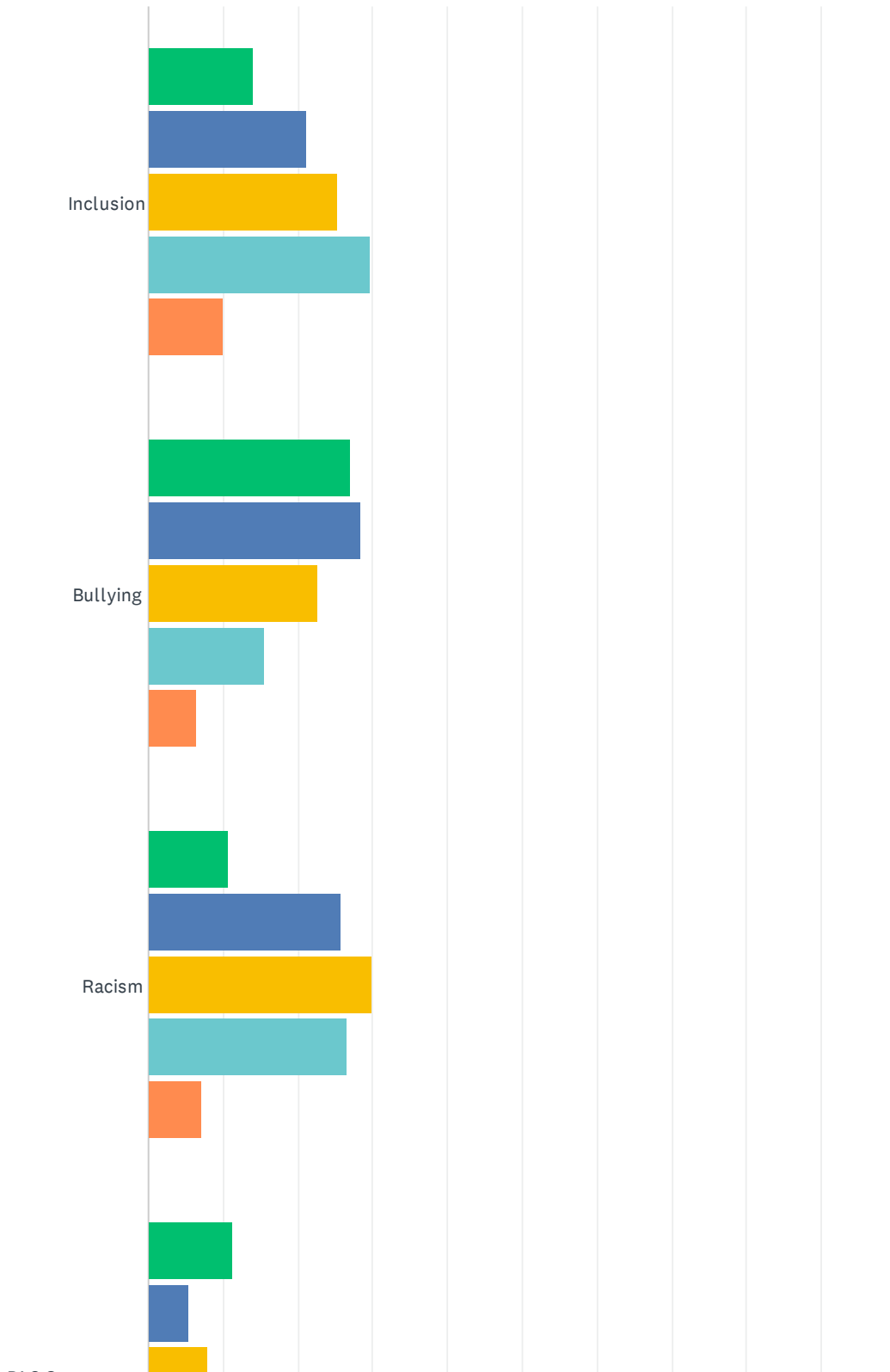

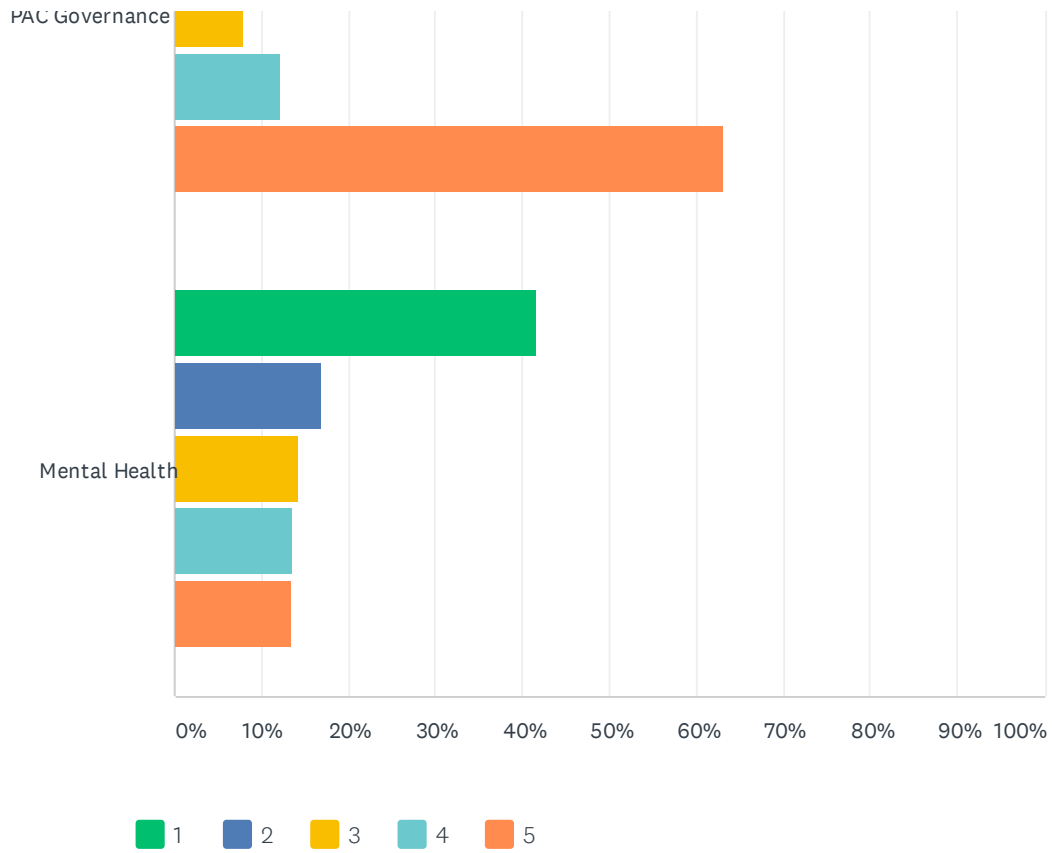
