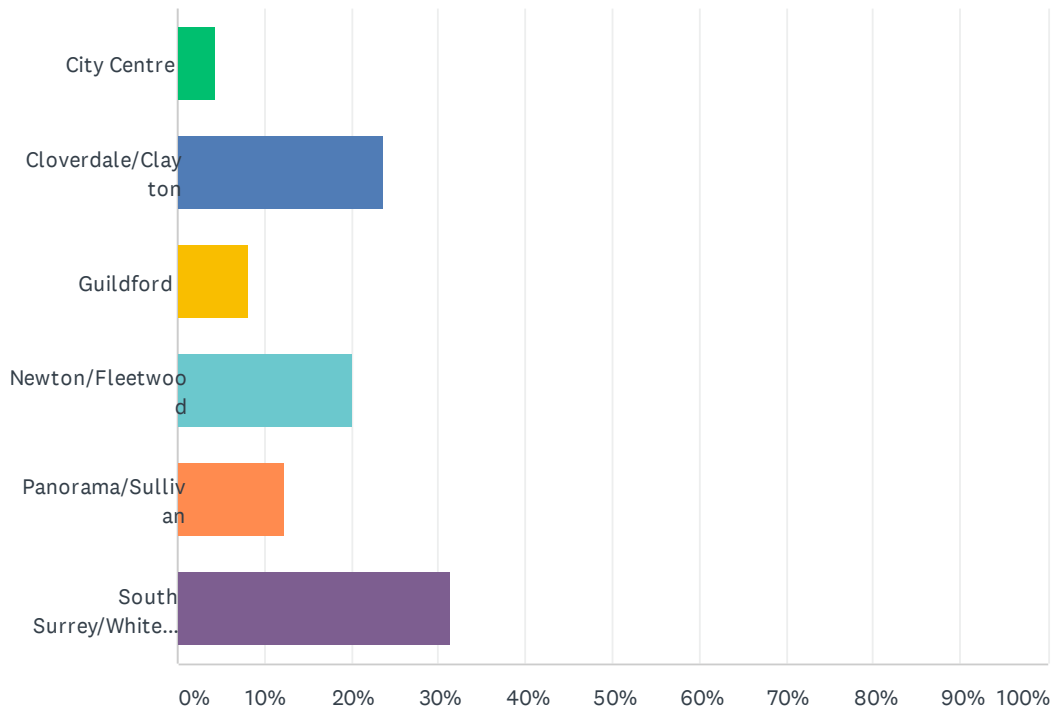


# Q1 What area of Surrey is your child(ren)'s school in? (Check here if you are unsure.)

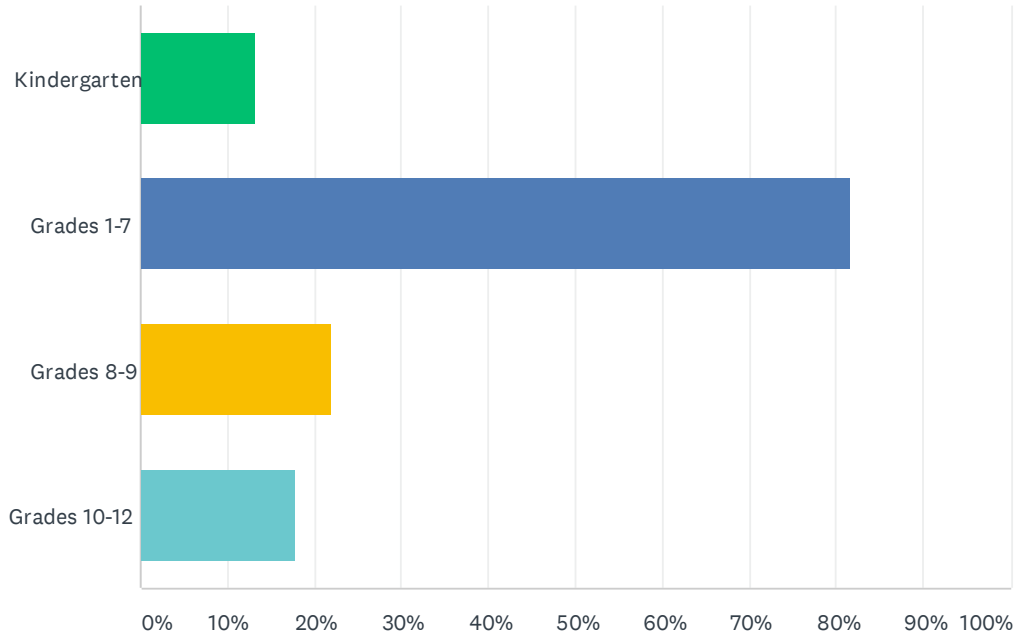

## Q2 What grades will your child(ren) be going into in September? (check all that apply)

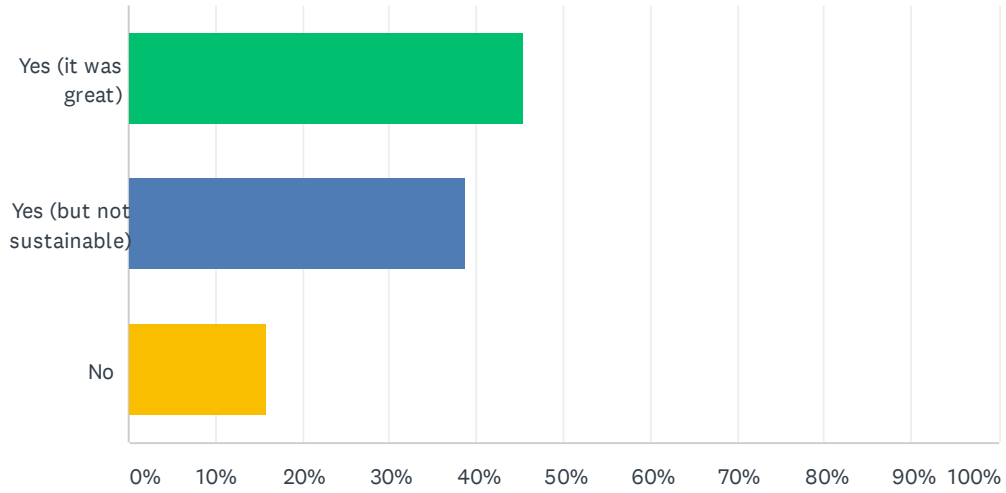

### Q3 Did the online/remote learning model that we had in the spring work for your family?

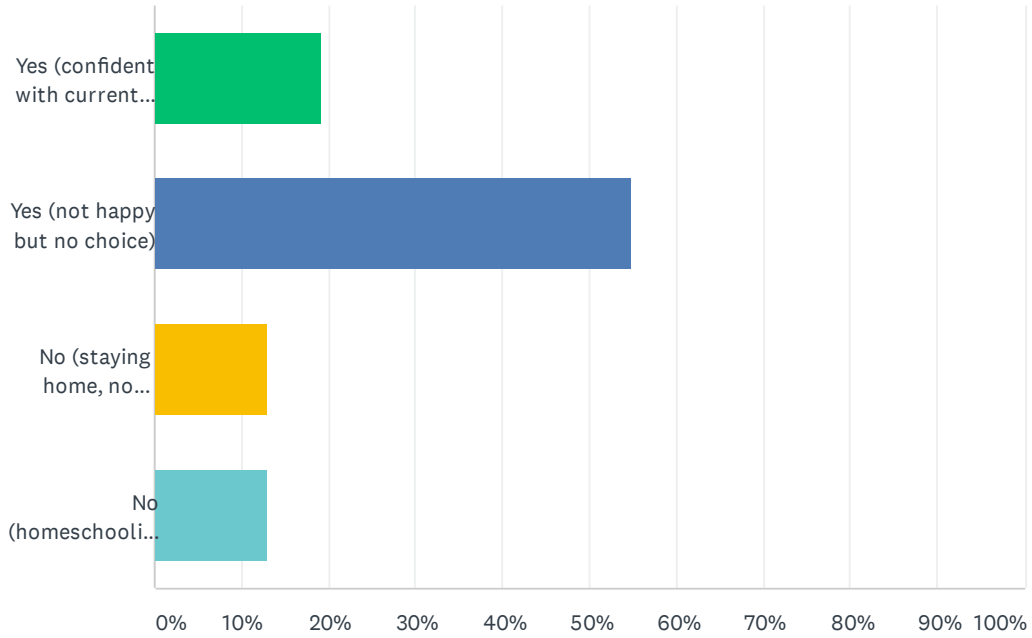

### Q4 With the current Surrey District Back to School Plan in place, are you planning on sending your child back to school?

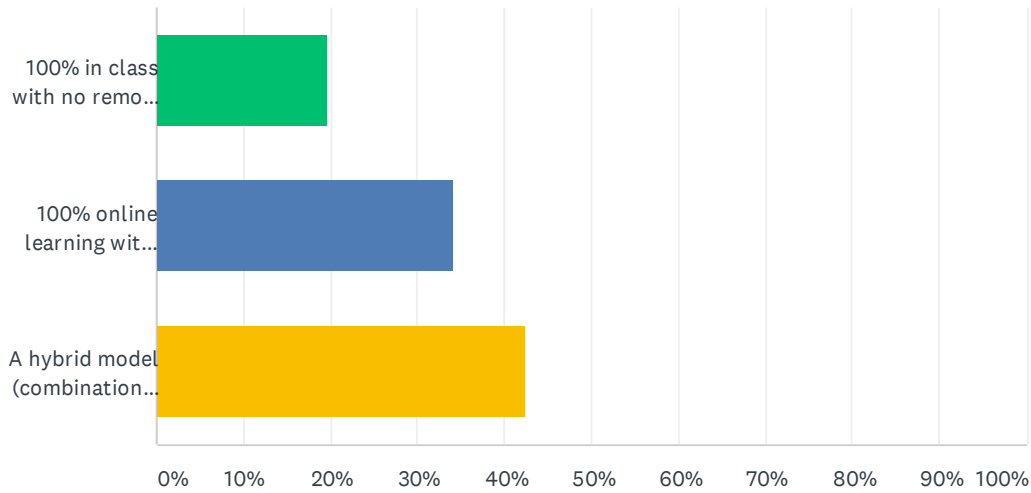

## Q5 If given an option, what would you prefer for elementary school?

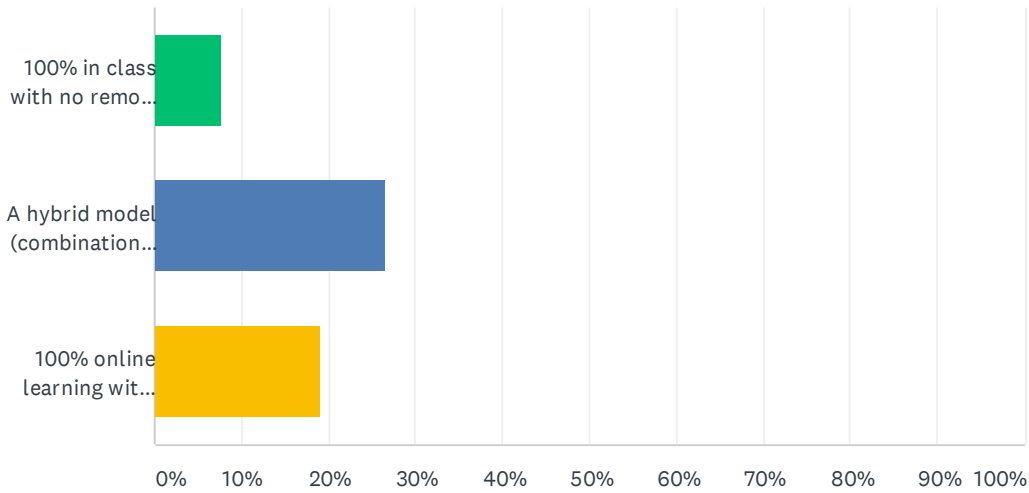

## Q6 If given an option, what would you prefer for secondary school?

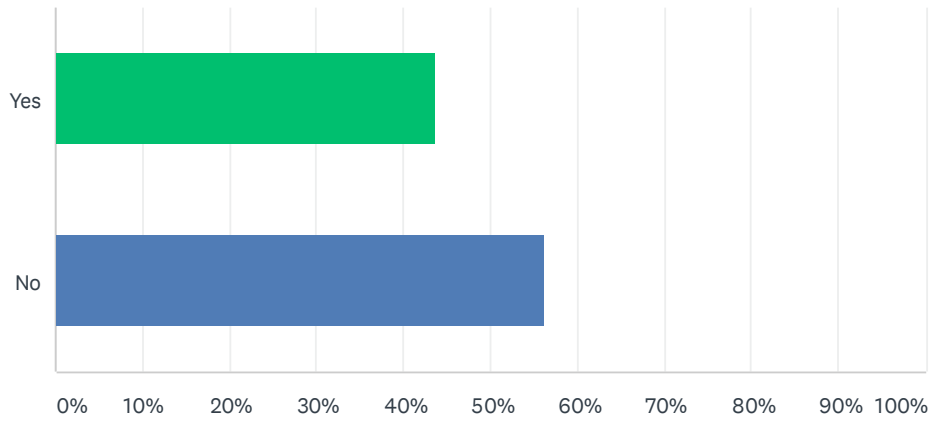

## Q7 Does your household have any immunocompromised members?

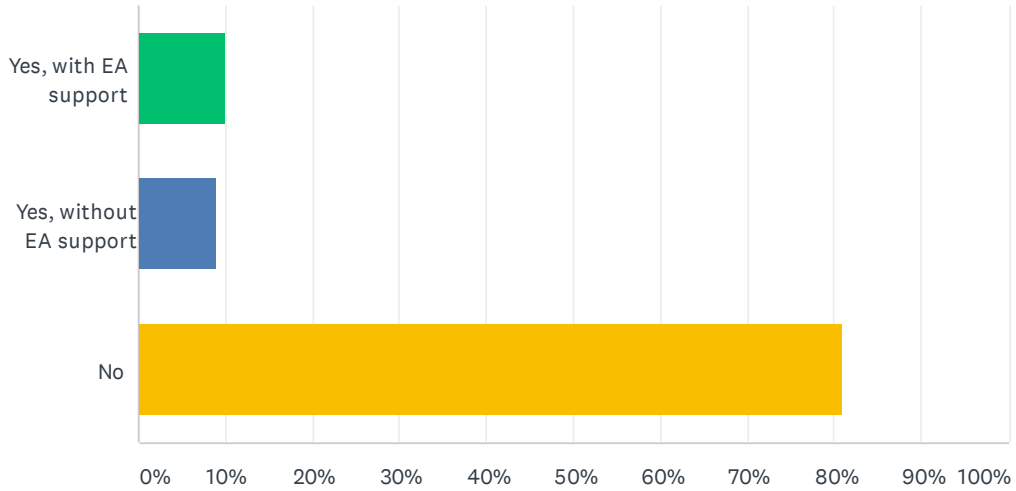

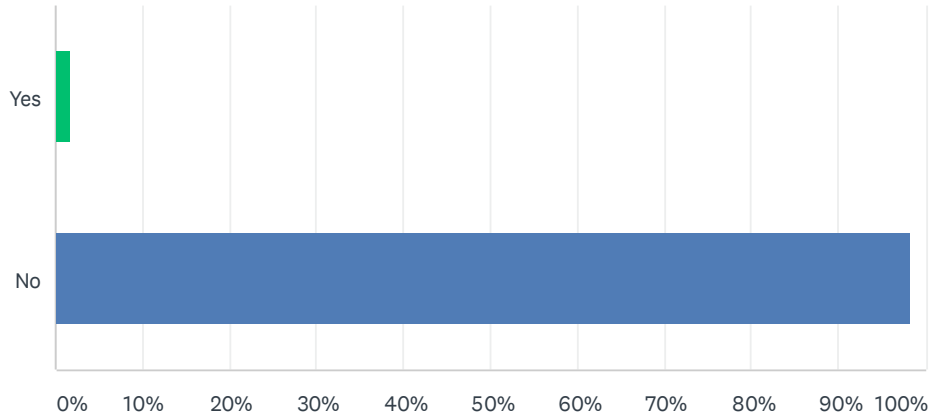

### Q9 Do you have a child enrolled in a District Partnership Program (eg. carpentry, automotive, or metal fabrication)?

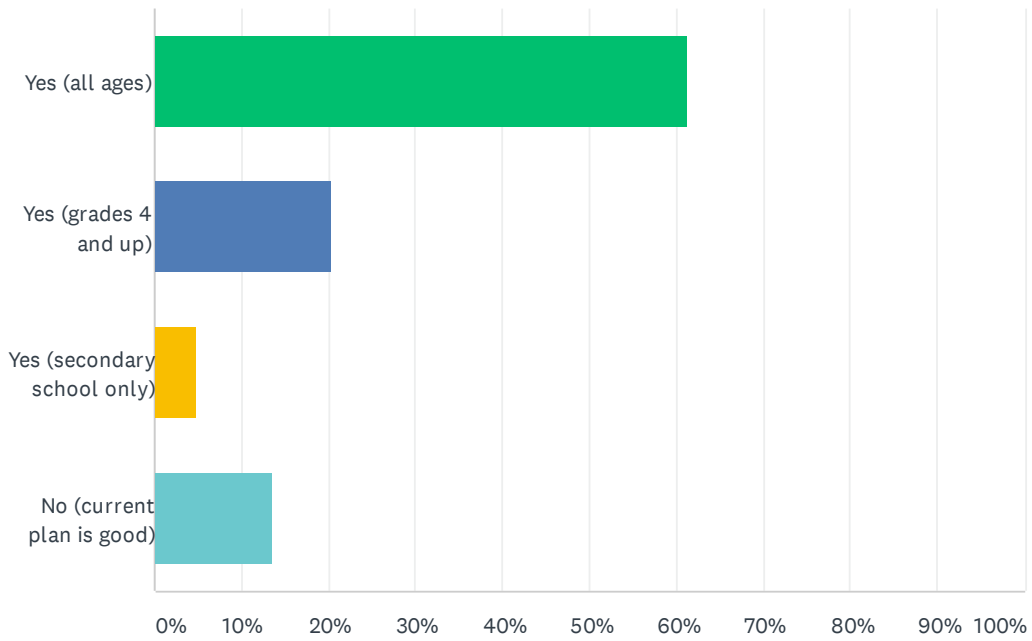

## Q10 Would you like masks to be required in classrooms for all students and teachers?

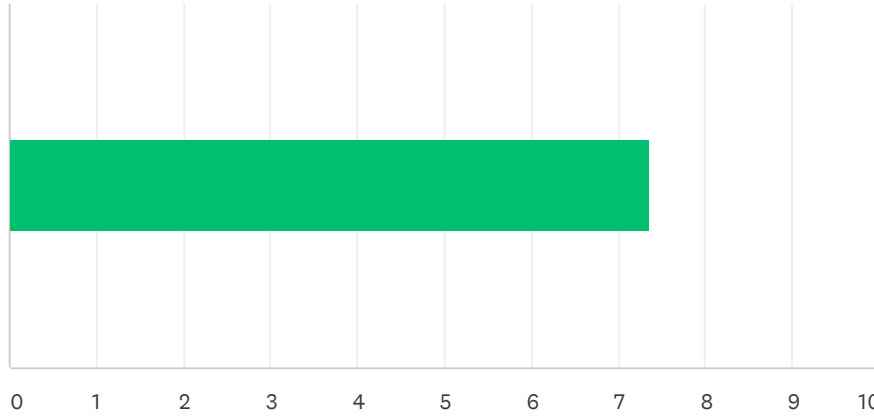
